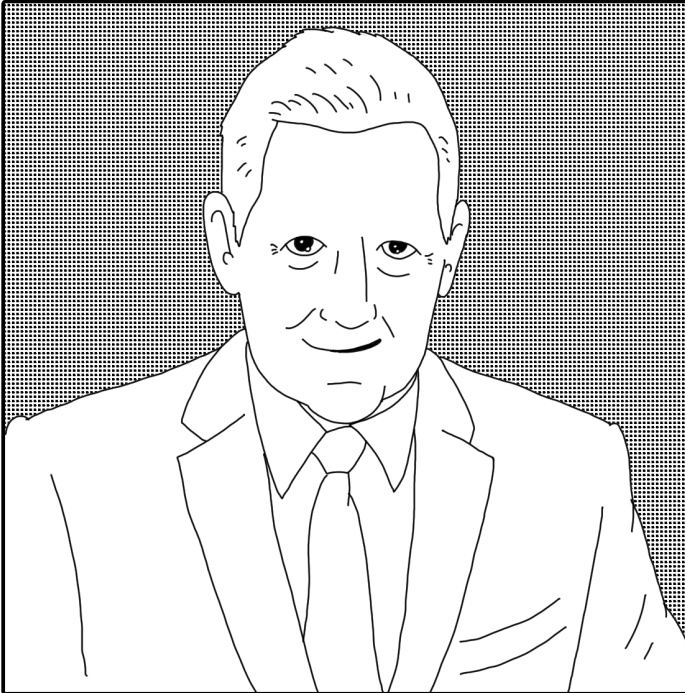
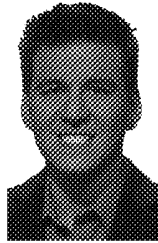


THIS IS JEOPARDY!

THE ONLY EPISODE TREBEK HASN'T HOSTED WAS ON APRIL 1st, 1997 WHEN HE AND PAT SAKAK FROM WHEEL OF FORTUNE SWITCHED JOBS.

ON ANOTHER APRIL FOOL'S DAY SHOW IN 2005, ALEX APPEARED ON JEOPARDY WITHOUT PANTS!

IN 2011, TREBEK TORE HIS ACHILLES TENDON CHASING A BURGLAR OUT OF HIS HOTEL ROOM!

SINCE JUNE 13, 2014, ALEX TREBEK HAS HELD THE GUINNESS WORLD RECORD FOR MOST EPISODES HOSTED OF A SINGLE GAME SHOW AT OVER 7,000 FOR JEOPARDY!

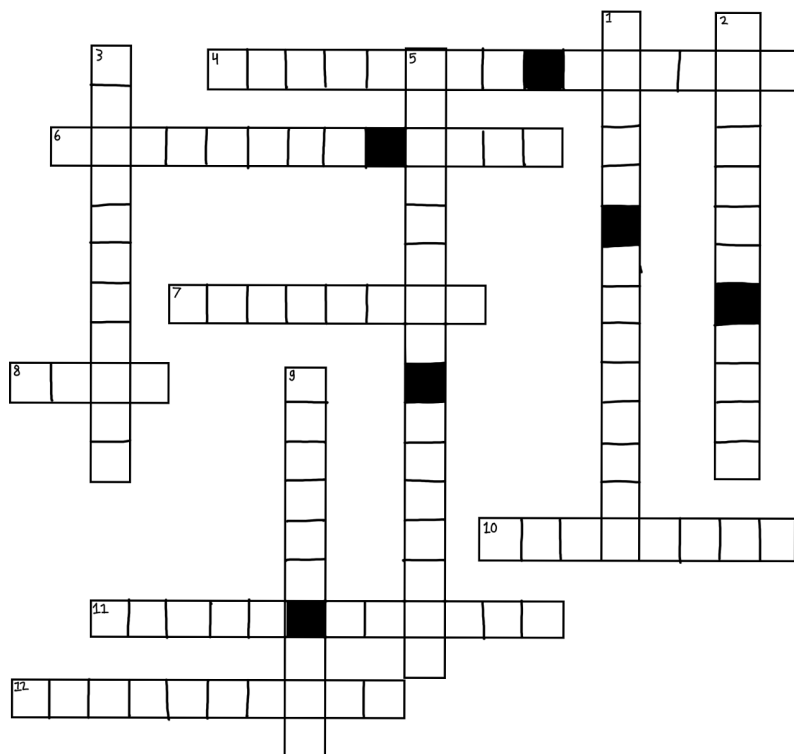

1. This monument is on South Dakota's flag in writing, but isn't pictured.
2. Ding dong! The first Forever stamps, issued in 2007, featured this iconic symbol.
3. This national park has the world's greatest concentration of geysers
5. The Big Room & the Kings Palace are among the many tours available at this New Mexico landmark.
9. To tour this dam's power plant, you have to take an elevator 530 ft. down through the rock wall of Black Canyon.
